INFANT JESUS SCHOOL

Motto of the School: "Education for Peace, Progress & Prosperity"

The Capuchin Friars who are the followers of St. Francis of Assisi, who was born in Italy in the year 1181 and dedicated his entire life living and propagating the Universal Brotherhood, have drawn inspiration from their founder to live and work for the same brotherhood and to become instruments of Peace. Hence the motto of our school is "Education for Peace, Progress & Prosperity". Our school situated in the Western Ghats surrounded by Coffee Estates and the ever green fields of Kadri Midri village in Chikmagalur District. Infant Jesus School being a Christian Minority Institution was established on 4th June, 2005. Though the primary goal of the institution is to educate the Christian children, yet it is open to everyone irrespective of caste, creed and religion.

This school is under the management of Capuchin Friars Service Society, which is registered under the society's registration Act of 1960 (Mysore Act No. 17 of 1960). All the members of this society are Catholic Religious belonging to the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin. They live the Gospel Values and render service to the people who are poor, needy and marginalized. Infant Jesus School has its focus on all round education with emphasis on personal growth and character formation along with integral value based development of young students.

OUR MISSION:

Drawing inspiration from Jesus Christ we show a preferential love for the poor and the disadvantaged, through our mission of Education. Infant Jesus School provides a unique educational experience to every child in a safe and supportive environment that promotes personal attitudes of self-discipline, motivation and excellence in learning. Expressing our oneness with all people, we strive to build an Educative Community of the Management, Staff, Students and Parents who will interact with one another with love, trust, responsibility and a sense of belonging.

CORE VALUES, AIMS & OBJECTIVES

1. *Have faith in God cultivate basic qualities of character and a sense of moral and spiritual values*
2. *Learn to respect parents, elders, teachers and authority*
3. *Cultivate values like truth, forgiveness, self-sacrifice, honesty, justice and concern for others*
4. *Foster respect for life – plant, animal and human and to protect environment like our founder St. Francis of Assisi*
5. *Show respect to every religion and have tolerance in day-to-day interactions with the neighbours*
6. *Preserve Simplicity of life style and dignity of labour*

ADMISSIONS:

1. The management reserves to itself the right of admission
2. The Admission is done from May 15th onwards. The minimum age for admission to LKG is 3 years on May 31st.
3. New admission will be made subject to the vacancies in each class in the month of May
4. Every new pupil must bring:-
 - a) A Transfer certificate from a recognized school.
 - b) The Original Corporation/Panchayat Birth Certificate, if the child has not attended school before.
5. A candidate who has attended any recognized school cannot be admitted without a leaving certificate from the school attended
6. Special attention must be paid to entering correctly the name and date of birth of the child, caste and the Parents' names. Subsequent changes in the date of birth or name will not be permitted.

7. The twelve months tuition fee is to be remitted as indicated below:-

- 1st installment : Payable by 15th June
- 2nd installment : Payable by 15th September
- 3rd installment : Payable by 15th December

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

1. The application for leave should be made on the pages set aside for the purpose in the school calendar
2. For every absence, a written statement signed by the parent/guardian is required on the day the pupil returns. If the student is absent for more than 3 days for reasons of ill health, a medical certificate from a doctor is required stating illness and fitness
3. All explanatory notes for absence and late arrival should be handed over to the class teacher. No one who is late or has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without the permission of the headmaster
4. Outside the vacation period, pupils are not granted leave. Hence, prior permission should be sought for absence from the school for any reason known or planned in advance.
5. Students will not be allowed to leave the school before the stipulated time unless parents/guardians present a written request to the headmaster.
6. Any student requiring leave for any part of the day on account of sudden illness or such unavoidable circumstances should obtain the permission of the class teacher and the headmaster before leaving the school. Leave record signed by parent/guardian should be submitted to the headmaster on the next working day.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All the pupils must abide by the school rules of conduct and discipline and must bear in mind the following points:-

1. Pupils should be punctual and regular
2. Pupils should be in correct, neat, clean and tidy uniform
3. Books or Magazines not approved by the school authorities must not be brought into the school; in case they are brought, they shall be confiscated
4. Speaking in English is a “must” when in school. The respective language must be used during the language classes
5. The primary civic duty is to guard public property. School property is public property and care should be taken to protect it. Any damage done to school property must be made good by the parent or guardian of the child
6. Every student must have a minimum of 85% attendance to be eligible to appear for the annual exams/be promoted to the next class
7. Students should not carry mobile phones to school, if found with mobiles, the same will be confiscated and returned only at the end of the academic year

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

1. It is vital that changes in residence/office addresses and telephone number be communicated in writing to the office immediately when they occur
2. Pupils are advised not to have private tuitions. Parents are urged to encourage their children to do their daily work diligently and honestly and to pay utmost attention to the studies in the class room. If there be real need for help and special attention, kindly contact the headmaster

3. parents are encouraged to have their children undergo medical examination regularly for general well-being, specially dental, eye and ear care
4. Collection of funds for whatever use is forbidden without prior permission of the headmaster
5. The school is not responsible for the articles lost. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles like expensive watches, ornaments of gold or silver garments, etc. to the school. Books, Tiffin carriers, sweaters should bear the name of the pupil and he/she will be the sole responsible person for its safe-keeping
6. Every student must have a copy of the school calendar and it should be brought to the school everyday. Parents should carefully go through the calendar daily and sign their remarks when required
7. Each student's safety is a major concern of the school, Therefore the following should be strictly observed
 - a) parents of pre-primary students are required to teach their children their names, address and telephone numbers by-heart
 - b) if the child has to go to a place other than the normal one, a note from the parent must be sent to the school, requesting permission and stating the reason for a child to go to a different place after the school

PARENT – TEACHER INTERACTION

1. The co-operation and good will of the parents is an essential component of an effective parent-teacher relationship in order to provide maximum educational opportunities for children. The school needs the involvement of parents in many of its activities
2. Parents and guardians shall co-operate with the school by adhering to the rules and regulations as amended from time to time

3. Parents should see that their children are dressed properly and neatly with the particular uniform prescribed for the day
4. Parents are encouraged to give positive suggestions for the improvement of academic standards
5. Parents are requested to supervise the daily Homework of their ward and duly sign their homework diary every day after the completion and counter check and thus co-operate with the teachers
6. It is the duty of the parents to provide necessary infrastructure and material for their daily duties at home
7. Children should not be kept at home or called for during working hours for unnecessary and trifle reasons
8. Progress cards of the students after each semestral examination are to be collected by the parents personally from the class teacher and to be duly signed in the presence of the teacher. This will help the parent-teacher to have a dialogue about the ward and take adequate steps to improve the over all growth of the ward
9. Parents are absolutely forbidden to enter the classrooms when the classes are on. They may meet the teachers before or after the class hours only
10. No parent is allowed to walk on the verandah or enter the classroom for any reason. They are advised to contact in the school office or in the principal's chamber for any necessity
11. Parents/ guardian are requested to make known their grievances or complaints in writing directly to the principal and not to the teacher concerned
12. All dues must be cleared before a student is admitted to the terminal and final examinations

EVALUATION & PROMOTION

Regular unit tests, monthly tests and terminal examinations are held each year and promotion is based on total performance at these tests and exams and regular attendance. It is the policy of the School not to fail a student as far as possible. At the same time a student who has not acquired the necessary skills to study in a higher class may be not promoted. Infant Jesus School is interested in providing additional possible facilities for slow or weak learners to acquire the needed skills if parents cooperate with the School in this regard. However, the school strongly discourages the practice of excessive home work, special tuition, etc.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION/RE-ADMISSION

1. All those students who have studied in our school during the academic year 2009-2010 are to be re-admitted to the coming year before the 25th of May, 2010. Progress card should be produced during the re-admission together with the candidate
2. Before re-admission, each student should obtain the prospectus and fill in the details required and submit it to the headmaster for signature
3. At least 25% of the tuition fee has to be paid during the admission/re-admission besides the total computer fee and development fee. The remaining amount could be paid in 2 installments as specified in the rules for admission
4. School book stall will function from 25th May onwards. All the students should buy the books from the school bookstall before the re-opening of the school
5. Those who need school uniform should place the order immediately after the admission/re-admission, paying 50% of the uniform charges
6. The school re-opens on the 1st of June, 2010 and all the students should to be present on the re-opening day for a prayer service at 9.40 a.m. on the school grounds
